

## New SMILE technology at Central Coast Day Hospital

Central Coast Day Hospital is the first in New South Wales and the third in Australasia, to adopt the SMILE flapless, keyhole laser vision correction of myopia and myopic astigmatism. **Dr Anil Arora** is one among the few surgeons in Australia who use this innovative technology." The



results so far are very pleasing, with patients very happy with their visual outcome and post-operative comfort" said Dr Arora.

SMILE stands for SMall Incision Lenticule Extraction. The procedure uses the Visumax femtosecond laser made by Carl Zeiss Meditec to perform a complete refractive correction, with no use of an excimer laser. The Visumax laser cuts a convex lenticule of tissue in the mid-corneal stroma and a small 4mm long side incision. The lenticule is then removed through the side incision, resulting in flattening of the central cornea and correction of myopia. **Read more**
